

# NC CPRG Statewide Implementation Grant Snapshot

Total Budget - \$199.9 million

## Transportation \$65 million

Program #1: RFPs for the replacement of vehicles (government, non-government, and fleet) to cleaner vehicles with an emphasis on vehicle electrification, and RFPs for Level 2 charging infrastructure at multi-unit dwellings and publicly accessible charging.

Program #2: Significantly increase efficiency of freight container shipping system to reduce GHG emissions and foster many other benefits.

Program #3: Fund bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure projects and regional/local planning efforts that support the adoption of VMT reduction measures by local businesses and other organizations.

## Buildings \$60 million

Program #1: Something Old is New Again: Harnessing the Power of the Weatherization Assistance Program + (WAP+).

Program #2: Appreciating Our Treasures: Electrifying and Creating Energy Efficiency in North Carolina's State-owned Buildings, Community Colleges and UNC System campuses.

Program #3: Energy Efficiency for Local Government Buildings in North Carolina.

## Industry \$15 million

Program #1: Provide energy assessments and technical assistance.

Program #2: Establish workforce training & continuing education support programs.

Program #3: Establish an energy loan financing program.

## Waste \$15 million

Program #1: RFP for approaches to divert organics from landfills by directing food to communities in need, and creating organic resources through composting or digestion.

Program #2: RFP for conversion of diesel refuse trucks to electric motors or lower-carbon fuels.

Program #3: RFP for projects that reduce landfill gas emissions through improved landfill operations to collect gas more efficiently and earlier in a landfill life.

\$15.4 million

Project #1: Regional Efficiency for Homes and Buildings Program

#### Transportation

Project #2: A Systems approach to reducing VMT's while enhancing mobility access.

### Centralina COG (Charlotte area)

\$19.6 million

#### Buildings

Project #1: Site-specific program to decarbonize industrial buildings.

Project #2: Support programs to increase energy efficiency in multi-unit residential buildings housing elderly, disabled adults and veterans.

#### Transportation

Project #1: Regional VMT reduction through transportation demand management, transit system coordination, incentives, and LIDAC micromobility.

Administrative Costs at 5% - Total of \$10 million
