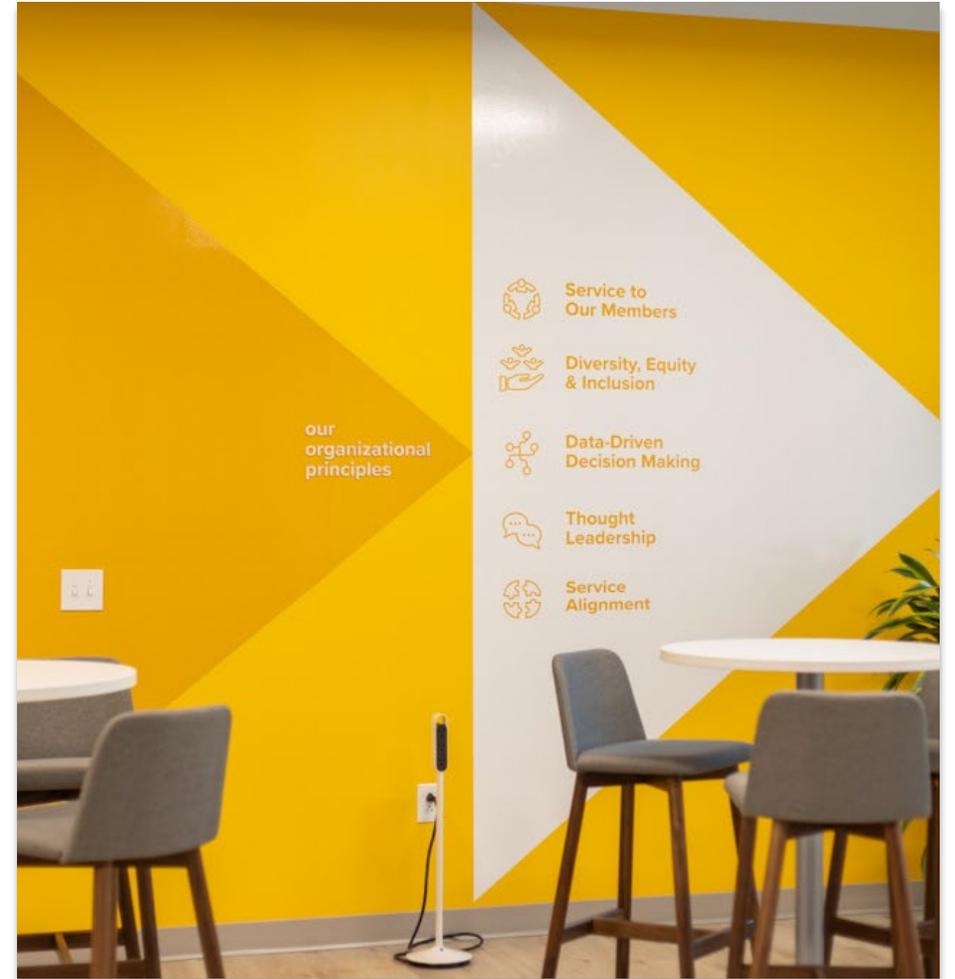
Regional Day Overview

 - Strengthen partnerships across jurisdictions



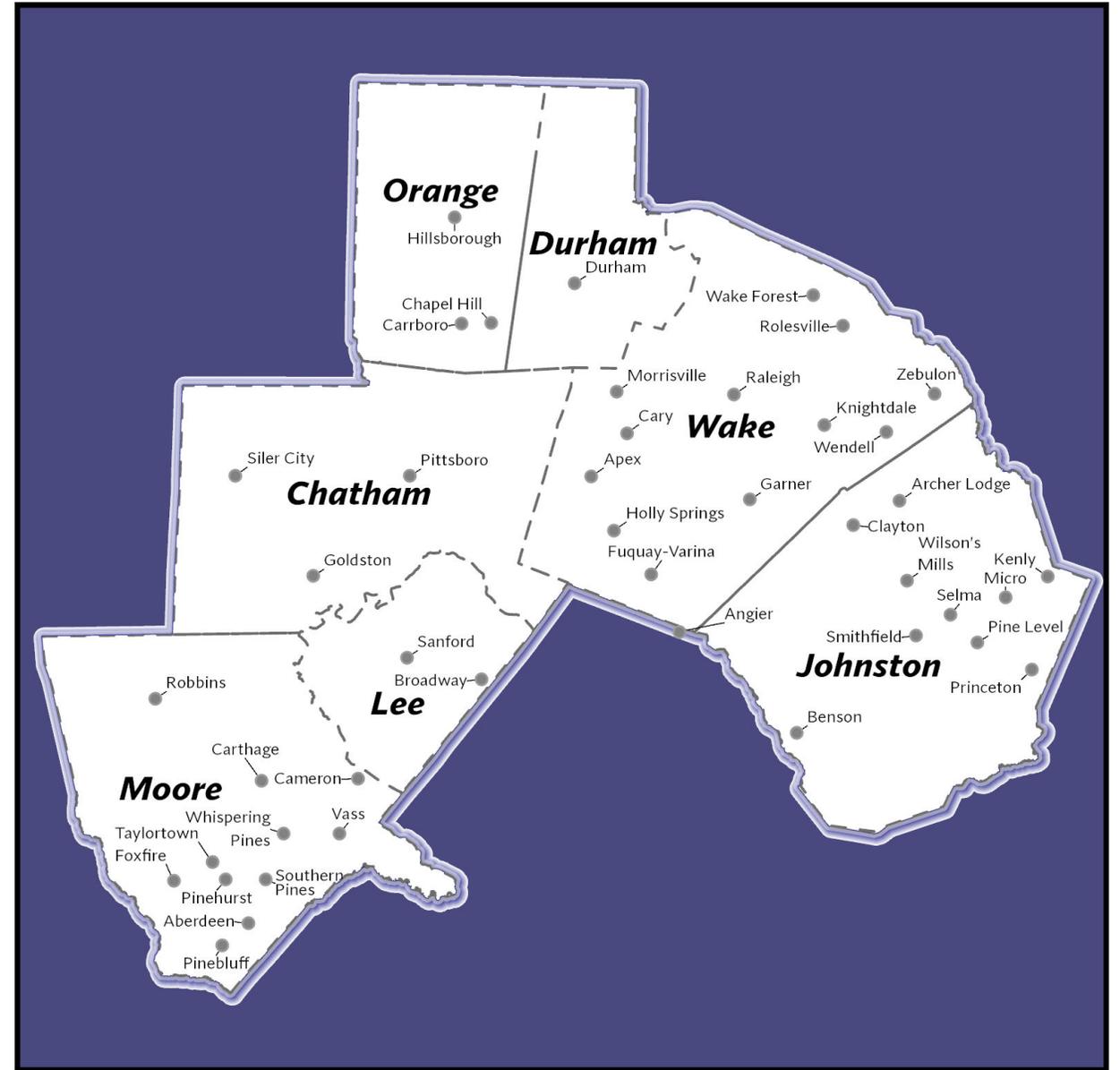
WHO WE ARE

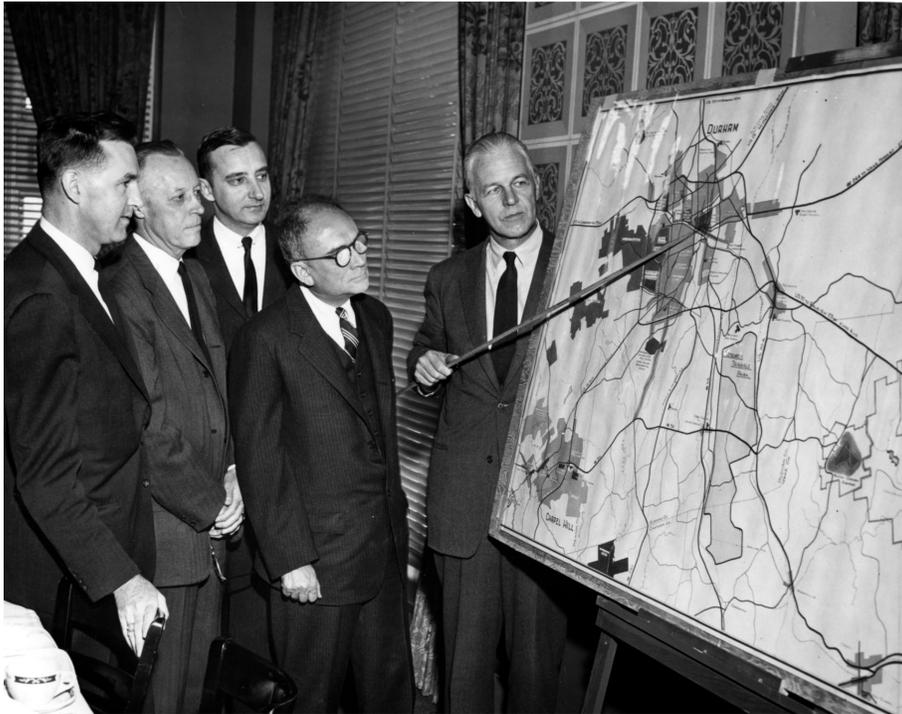

- Nation's first regional water quality management plan
- Identification of need for regional transit authority and formation of GoTriangle (TTA).
